1. Review of the minutes of previous meeting & action taken (held on 25.11.2024)

2. <u>Discussions in the previous Department Discipline Coordinators committee meeting</u> (held on 07.05.2025)

2	All the Labs should be equipped with speaker so that all the students get the information.

4	Introduce bouncers to monitor discipline at the gates and other places in the college premises.	

3. Disciplinary cases reported during even semester of the academic year 2024-2025.

- 528 number of cases were booked through mobile app for student late to the college and improper dress code. Respective mentors & HoDs dealt the deviations of the students with the intimations to parents.
- 2. Seven Students from II-year B.E(1 student from ECE, 2 from AI &DS, 2 from CSE, 2 from Mech) were suspended for two weeks for their involvement in a clash on 10.02.2025. With the severe warning and undertaking signed by their parents, one student was fined Rs.15000/- towards poor student's welfare fund and the other six students were fined Rs.10000/-
- 3. Five students from II-year mechanical students misbehaved during the Industrial visit on 13.03.2025. All the students were suspended for three weeks. With the severe warning and undertaking signed by their parents, four students were fined Rs. 15000/- towards poor student's welfare fund, one student was fined Rs. 2,000/- based on their involvement in the issue.
- 4. Two students from final civil quarreled on 2.4.2025. The students were suspended for four weeks. With the severe warning and undertaking signed by their parents, one student was fined Rs.10,000/- towards poor student's welfare fund and the other student was given a warning.

- 5. Three students (Two students from I AI &DS, one student from IV CSE) were quarrelled on 6.5.2025. All the students were suspended for two weeks. With the severe warning and undertaking signed by their parents, one student who involved severely was fined Rs.7,500/- towards poor student's welfare fund, other one fined Rs.5,000/- and next one Rs.1,000 depends their involvement in the issue.
- 6. Four students (3 students from I year Mechanical, one student from I-CSE misbehaved on 24.5.2025. All the students were suspended for two weeks. With the severe warning and undertaking signed by their parents, one hostel student was fined Rs.10,000/- towards poor student's welfare fund, other one fined Rs.2,000/- and decided to give TC for two students or apply for transfer.

4. Discussion and Decisions

- Discipline duty should be assigned to all professors, Associate Professors and Assistant Professors.
- During exam time, the discipline duty is scheduled to be from 8.30 a.m. to 9.30 a.m.
- Proper dress code should be monitored during exam time.
