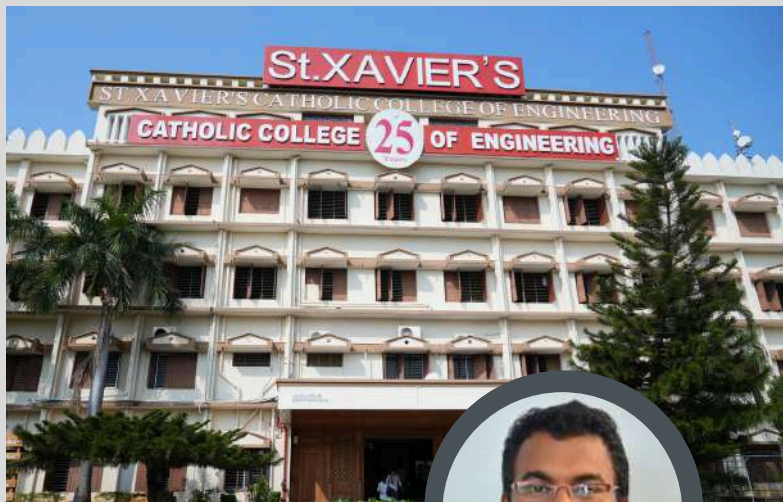

## ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES
